- •\$1000 is available for college or university expenses.
- The scholarship funds are provided by the Oregon Tualatin Valley Amateur Radio Club.
- •The selection process will include reviewing individual applications and interviews of the finalists by the Oregon Tualatin Valley Amateur Radio Club Scholarship Committee.
- Applicants must be a US citizen, have an amateur radio license (any level) and have a minimum 3.00 high school GPA or equivalent, among other requirements.





Scholarship submissions are due by March 31, 2021.
