As we restart the SEA-PAC website, there will be a few changes: to the registration process:

- There will <u>only</u> be online and in-person registration
 - Mail-in registration is longer be available
 - You can register online through the SEA-PAC website or at the Registration Desk at the convention
- All convention document packets will be "Will Call"
 - Convention documents (badge, Workshop, Banquet tickets, etc.) will <u>not</u> be mailed
 - Your convention documents will be waiting for you at the Registration "Will Call" Desk at the convention

Remember, your \$10 online adult admission is valid for both Saturday and Sunday. The student rate for ages 13-17 is only \$5. For children 12 and under, admission is FREE with a paid adult admission. Bring the family for a great vacation on the Oregon coast. - •The scholarship funds are provided by the Oregon Tualatin Valley Amateur Radio Club.
- •The selection process will include reviewing individual applications and interviews of the finalists by the Oregon Tualatin Valley Amateur Radio Club Scholarship Committee.
- Applicants must be a US citizen, have an amateur radio license (any level) and have a minimum 3.00 high school GPA or equivalent, among other requirements.

Scholarship submissions are due by March 31, 2022.

Important SEA-PAC Drawing and Raffle Information

SEA-PAC is restructuring its Prize Drawings and Raffles to be compliant with all applicable laws.

The regulations as handed down by the Oregon Department of Justice are very specific and are forcing many changes to SEA-PAC's Drawings and Raffles.

As an example, Drawing and Raffle tickets can no longer be sold through online Registration as that would violate interstate gaming laws and bundling Drawing and Raffle tickets with Registration or other convention products is not legal in Oregon.

SEA-PAC Workshops, Friday, June 3

DX and Contesting after the Solar Minimum: Improve your DX success with presentations from top DX and Contest hams. Morning talks include: Emission standards applied, DX success with low power, and Shack fire: rebuild an ideal ham shack. Also learn more about propagation and Cycle 25 predictions from K9LA in the afternoon. \$20, limit 110 seats.

Emergencies Happen. Are you ready?: Are you ready for an emergency in your neighborhood or community? Come learn from some who experienced such events to better prepare. Talks include Results of a wildfire that nuked a community, Emission standards applied, Leave now! What to take, Disaster response, ESF2 amateur radio and FEMA, and further disaster operating experiences. \$20, Limit 200 seats.

Build a Balun or Unun: Build a balun or unun (100-watt variety) to improve you station. Learn why you may need one, and the techniques to build you own. Fee covers the parts; we provide the tools to build your own. \$35, limit 20 seats.

Possible Workshop on Basic Electronics: If we find a venue this week, you will no longer be a newbie after the workshop. Fee \$70 includes thumb drive with software for home study, and a basic multimeter. Watch the *SEA-PAC* website and Registration page. Bring a laptop. Limit 50 seats.
